
CELEBRATING GROUND STAFF AND STRAPPER AWARDS

With a total prize pool of over \$10,000 - these awards aim to increase engagement with stables, trainers and staff as individuals or as a team.

To be eligible each nominee must be employed under a trainer who has a registered jumps racing licence in 2023.

Each category has been carefully created to highlight the individual achievements in each different category.

This recognition program is designed to encourage horse owners, trainers, clubs, office staff & administration within the Jumps Racing Industry to engage and participate. By acknowledging the individual achievements the AJRA hope to build a strong comardary within the sport. It is our intention to celebrate these awards each year at the annual jumps racing awards night where the recipient can be celebrate amongst their peers.





AWARDED CATEGORIES FOR 2023

HORSEMANSHIP AWARD

This is to be awarded to a participant who has shown skill in horsemanship either on the ground or while riding track work. The winning applicant will be awarded for their ability to work with horses with a focus on their care and wellbeing. This award also highlights the connection the staff member has to animals and their talent in the area of horsemanship both on and off the track.

EXCELLENCE IN PRESENTATION ON RACE DAY AWARD

An award highlighting the presentation of horse and their strapper. Consistent care in presentation and turnout will be highlighted by those who nominate them. We encourage owners to watch and assess their horses' turnout on race day while at the track or via racing.com.

EQUINE WELFARE LIFE AFTER JUMPS RACING AWARD

This award is dedicated to those who are passionate about rehoming jumps horses in their post racing career. The nominee's commitment to the horses they care for both during its racing career and after will be key factors for this award.



AWARDS Q&A

Who is eligible for the awards?

The awards are open to any ground staff or strapper who is employed by a trainer who holds a jumps licence.

Who can nominate?

Nominations can be made by any participant in the jumps racing industry. We encourage owners, trainers, staff members and nominees themselves (must provide one reference) to nominate for the awards.

When do nominations open?

Nominations will be open from the 30 June and will close 31 August, 2023.

How do I nominate?

By completing the online form via the AJRA website.

Can I nominate myself?

Nominees can definitely nominate themselves. You must provide details of one reference as part of your nomination.

Who decides the winners?

A dedicated judging panel at the AJRA & Country Racing Victoria will judge the applications with the awards being presented at the Jericho Cup in 2023.
